# INFORMATION FOR ARTISTS

### ARTIST FEES

Artists retain 100% of their sales. No commission will be charged by MAGG.

#### PROFESSIONAL ARTISTS (15 spaces available)

\$350 for a 2.5' x 6' display space

Professional Artist is defined as someone who earns a living as a jewelry artist or teacher of metalsmithing.

Professional Artists who have taught at MAGG within the last year will receive a 20% discount.

#### PART-TIME ARTISTS (15 spaces available)

\$200 for a 2.5' x 6' display space

Part-Time Artist is defined as someone who makes jewelry for fun or has sold their work at a few jewelry shows.

A Part-Time Artist may request to share a display space with one other Part-Time Artist. Each pair of artists must share one 2.5' x 6' table.

Artists who request to share a display space will be paired on a first-come, first-served basis. Availability of shared display spaces is limited and, therefore, not guaranteed.

#### STUDENT ARTISTS (5 spaces available)

\$50 per artist, sharing display space at the MAGG table

Student Artist is defined as someone who has taken less than two years of jewelry or metalsmithing classes.

Student Artists may exhibit up to 10 items each.

## TERMS & CONDITIONS

All images and Bio/Artist Statement must be received by September 12, 2022. Submissions not adhering to the Exhibition Requirements will be omitted. Any work not meeting the Metal Arts Guild of Georgia quality standards will not be accepted. Jurors' decisions are final, and acceptance into the show is not guaranteed. Selected artists will be notified via the email used for their submission on or before September 19th, 2022. The entry fee payment link will be emailed to selected artists, and payment is due by September 26th.

Participation is limited to MAGG Members only.

Acceptance is on a first-come, first-served basis, contingent upon juried selection.

By registering for this event, you are granting MAGG permission to use images of your work, your headshot, and your Bio/Artist Statement for promotional purposes. Your Bio/Artist Statement, as well as an image of you, will be posted on MAGG's website and used on social media in advance of the Jewelry Show. Images of your work may also be used on the website, social media, and/or MAGG emails to promote the Jewelry Show.

All images and Bio/Artist Statement must be received by September 12, 2022. These must be uploaded via the application form.

Artists will receive a response from the jury committee by September 19, 2022. Once your application is accepted, we will send you a contract to sign and a link to pay for your space.

NO Refunds. If you are unable to attend the show, contact MAGG ASAP so we may contact someone on the waitlist.

The Artist is responsible for collecting and reporting all applicable sales taxes. Dekalb County sales tax is 8%.

Jewelry represented must be hand fabricated and representative of metalsmithing skills. No work assembled from commercial elements is permitted.

Artists must be present to sell their own work. Artists cannot employ sales agents or representatives in lieu of attending the sale.

Each Professional Artist and Part-Time Artist (or pair of artists, if sharing) will have an eight (8) foot space, large enough for one six (6) foot table or display of similar dimension. You must bring your own table and chair.

There will be a limited number of tables for rent at a cost of \$30 each. This includes one chair. Additional chairs can be rented at \$5 per chair. Tables and chairs are available on a first-come, first-served basis.

Electricity is available at all spaces. LED lighting is recommended for individual spaces.

Wi-Fi will be available. However, it is up to the individual artist to bring a device with cell data or be able to tether to your phone to process credit cards with a service like Square, Apple Pay, Zelle, etc. In addition, bring enough cash (around \$100 in small bills) in order to accept payment in cash.

This is a group event, and its success is determined by participation by all. By registering for this event, you commit to helping with set up before the event and clean up at the close of the day. All participants agree to promote this event to their email lists, website, and on social media channels.

A "BE SHOW READY" training will be provided this fall to cover best practices in display, promotion, and great tips to make this a fun event.

The Metal Arts Guild of Georgia Annual Jewelry Show will be widely promoted via e-mail, Google, Facebook and Instagram well in advance of November 12, 2022.

There is ample parking at the location.

Volunteers will be available to assist on set up day and the day of the event.

A police officer will be present for the duration of the sales event.
